Future Value to Engineering Profession / Enhanced Public Awareness

- > Engineered the future by rehabilitating 1930s Welch Ditch wooden flume and preserving 1870s Colorado Central Railroad stone walls
- > Tested cantilever bridge hung from cliffs for future project segments and new approach to permeable pavers to detain & treat water

- > 14 recreational uses, from wheelchairs to biking, hiking to rock
- Wall stone veneer obtained from abandoned onsite quarry; restored Welch Ditch flume with timbers from closed sections

Complexity &

- > 1.75-mile trail traverses creekside cliffs. rockfall areas, riparian areas, and historic features; maintained ADA-accessible grades of under 5%
- > Trailhead parking areas and highway turn lanes strategically arranged for traffic safety and rock cut avoidance
